Exiting Poverty: Does Gender Matter?

Little is understood about the factors associated with poverty duration in Canada, or which factors, if any, may affect women and men differently. Moreover, research pays scant attention to how far Canadians transition out of poverty.

In this webinar, we will present recent research results that shed light on this question. Using data from the Canadian Survey of Labour and Income Dynamics (SLID), from 1993-1998 to 2005-2010, we will examine the determinants of poverty duration among women and men in Canada and poverty duration across different exit destinations: whether it is just above the poverty line or to higher income levels.
